Feasts 1, 2, 3 are about:

YESHUA = THE SUFFERING SERVANT.

Feast 4 is about:

COMFORTER FOR BELIEVERS = THE HOLY SPIRIT.

Feasts 5, 6, 7 are about:

YESHUA = THE FUTURE CONQUERING KING.

FEAST OF PASSOVER. In Hebrew it is PEH'-sakh

In the Bible, each day begins and ends at **sundown**.

Yeshua was killed 1 hour before sundown.

That hour became "day one" in His total 3 days to be dead.

It helps your Bible Studies if you own a Hebrew calendar.

Each year, find the "**7 Feasts of the LORD**" on your calendar.

Feast of Passover Yeshua died on a Cross on the day of a full moon.

Feast of Unleavened Bread Israeli's only food when they left Egypt.

Feast of First Fruits Yeshua was alive on Earth 3 days after His death.

Feast of Weeks The Holy Spirit's power increased to serve us on Earth.

Feast of Trumpets Be with Yeshua when He and Angels come to Earth.

Feast of Atonement Yeshua will make judgements when He returns.

Feast of Tabernacles We will live on Earth with Yeshua 1,000 years.

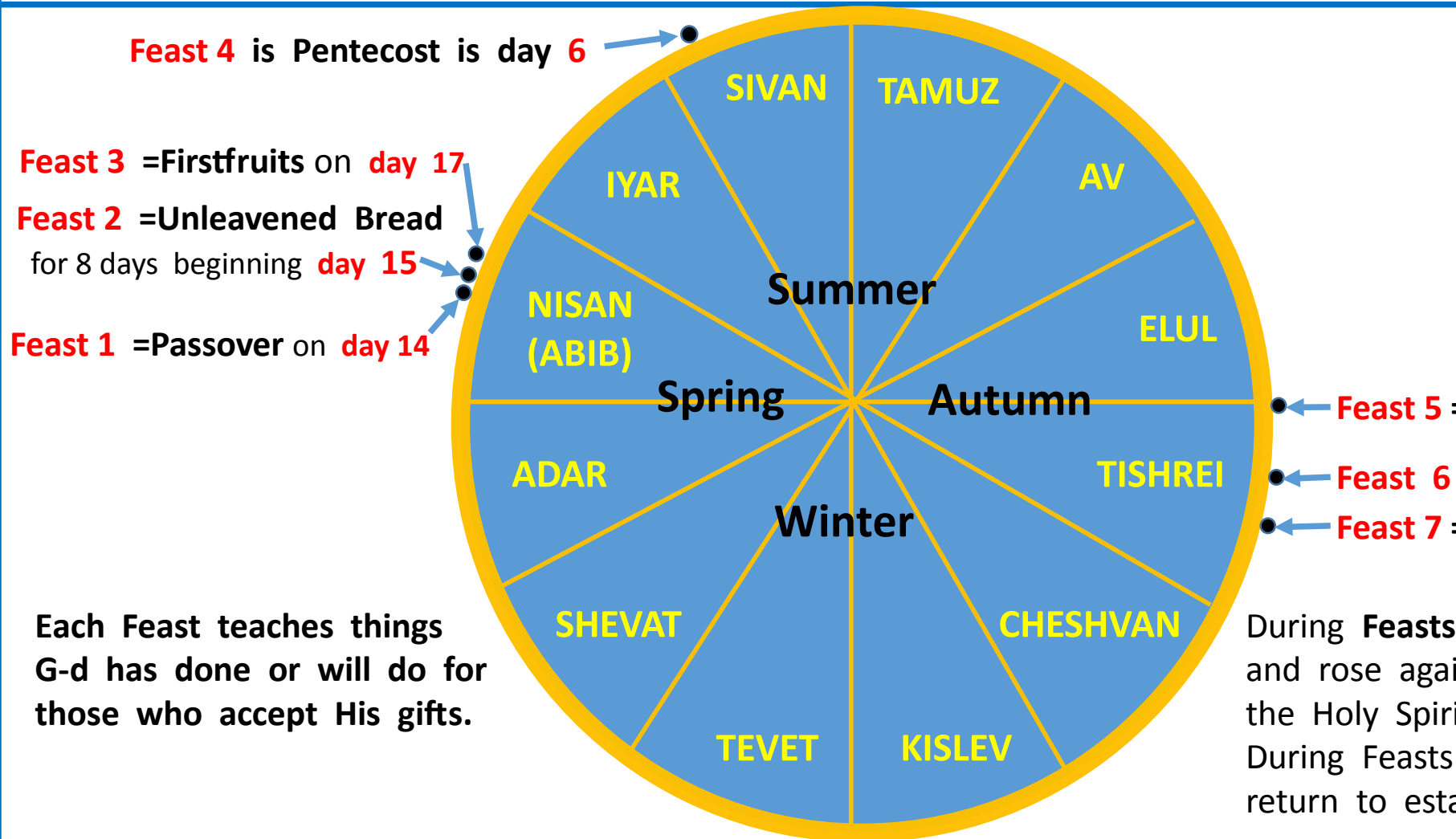

7 FEASTS OF THE LORD ARE ON EACH HEBREW CALENDAR

DAY 1 for each Hebrew month is a NEW MOON. DAY 14 for each Hebrew month is

3 things about each of the 7 Feasts.

Learn 3 things about each of the 7 Feasts.

1. What must the Jews do for each Feast?
2. What must Yeshua or the **Holy Spirit** do for each Feast?
3. What must **Gentles** do for each Feast?

These Scriptures about the 7 Feasts are not part of your 15-minute lesson. Study these Scriptures later to enjoy the Power of the Bible to teach you.

FEAST 1 (Passover) Exodus 12:21-51; Numbers 9:1-3; 28:16-25;
Deuteronomy 16:1-2; 5-6; Joshua 3:5-7; 5:2 – 6:1; 6:27; Luke 22: 7-20;
1Corinthians 5:7-8

FEAST 2 (Unleavened Bread) Exodus 33:12-34:26; Numbers 28:19-25;
Deuteronomy 16:3; Ezekiel 36:37-37:14; 1Corinthians 5:6-8.

FEAST 3 (Feast of Firstfruits - Yahweh was First-fruit to rise from the dead so others will be resurrected from the dead) Matthew 22:23b; Mark 9:9-10;
John 5:29; 11: 24; 17:23; Acts 23:6; 24:15; Romans 8:19 (We also will become the sons of God); Romans 8:29; 1Corinthians 13:20; 1Corinthians 15:20-23;
Colossians 1:18-20; 1Thessalonians 4:16; Hebrew 2:11; 6:2; * ^{YLT} Hebrew 12:23;
James 1:18

** ^{YLT} is the Young's Literal Translation that helps us avoid a weaker translation.*

Part 2: Three Spring Feasts celebrate things Yeshua did before you were born.

Israelites moved into Egypt in the Spring of 1876 B.C.

In the spring of 1446 B.C. There were 600,000 male Israelite slaves in Egypt. If you add women, children, and senior citizens, there were approximately 3 million who wanted to move to their Promised Land.

Part 2: This is a timeline for the first 3 FEASTS.

■ Israelites lived in Egypt in peace for 30 years (2091 B.C. - 2061 B.C.)

ISRAELITES WERE SLAVES IN EGYPT FOR 400 YEARS (2061 B.C. - 1661 B.C.)



“ Passover sacrificed lamb ” was the Eve of Nisan 14 in (1661 B.C.)



“ Feast of Unleavened Bread ” was Nisan 15 – 29 in (1661 B.C.)



“ Feast of Firstfruits ” was Nisan 17 (1661 B.C.)



YESHUA BECAME THE “ SACRIFICED LAMB ” WHO RAISED IN 3 DAYS AS “ FIRSTFRUITS ”
